Output is increased over the SD, but is not really a high output pickup, i play through a Matamp 1224 mk2 and it sounds extremely good, it cleans up nice on the volume pot and has plenty of bite just as a Tele should have. Mids are increased over stock (what i wanted) In combination with the original SD neck PU the extra position on my 4 way switch gives a really fat tone which is great for lead and is improved on how it used to sound. I play covers ranging from the 60's (Stones) to modern day (Arctic Monkeys) and in between (Jam / Weller), and in my opinion this PU has given me a tone and more variety - my Tele is reborn
