0;This was wound for me to go into one of my Carvin DC727's. I was looking for a more vintage single coil sound in neck position. It's replaced a Swineshead CL7. After the disgraceful treatment I received from that 'company' I didn't want their pickups in any of my guitars anymore. Also in comparison with the Smit's and Bareknuckles I've had for my other guitars the swinesheads weren't sounding so good anymore.


Sound Quality: 

The output is pretty pokey for a single coil thanks to the extra 1000 turns Allan gave it. I'll probably be using this with Keeley Blues Driver, SD-1 and DS-1 pedals into an ancient valve amp (selmer twin 30) driving various cabs loaded with Celestion Vintage 30's The sound is full and rounded. No mud or peaky stuff at all. There's a smoky quality to the cle and it distorts well. Think Steely Dan style lead breaks which is the ball park sound I have in mind. Bluesy/jazzy stuff Graydon and Carlton.
