0;I've got it at the bridge of my mid 90's Fat Tele with a 'tap' switch. Really easy install.


Sound Quality: 

This thing sounds great - with the tap it sounds like a really nice twangy tele pickup, great for country and some blues and rock stuff, turn the tap off and you get more in the mids and lows, just like a P90 should - really nice for blues and rock. It doesn't sound exactly like a traditional P90, but it comes pretty close, and you don't have to mess with your guitar to get it to fit, which is nice.

I've been playing for 22 years, and I put this in my tele about 5 years ago. It really opened up the guitar and made it easier to get sounds I was after for blues and rock, without sacrificing the twang I want for country. And it was incredibly cheap for the quality of the pickup, less than ££40. Obviously handmade, and done really well.
